THE SELECTION OF TREASURER ACT OF 2017

At a duly called Session of the Legislature of the Kiowa Tribe held this 10th day of June 2017, the following Resolution and Law were adopted.

WHEREAS; the Legislature is vested with the authority to pass laws and resolutions pursuant to Article VI, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the Kiowa Tribe, and confirm or deny certain nominations made by the Chairman pursuant to Article VI, Section 6(c) of the Constitution; and,

WHEREAS; the Legislature has determined that the Tribe is in urgent need of a Treasurer, who serves a critical function to safeguard the financial assets of the Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE IT RESOLVED; that the Legislature hereby enacts the attached law entitled, "The Selection of Treasurer Act of 2017".

Section 1.1 Short Title

This enactment shall be known as the "The Selection of Treasurer Act of 2017 ("Act").

Section 1.2 Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to direct the Chairman to make a nomination of a qualified candidate for Treasurer of the Tribe, subject to confirmation by the Legislature.

Section 1.3 Findings

The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:

- (a). Article VII, Section 4(d) of the Constitution calls for the Chairman to nominate a candidate for Treasurer, subject to confirmation by the Legislature, who has the responsibility to safeguard the financial assets and be responsible for the financial practices of the Tribe.
- (b). More than two months have passed since the BIA provided final approval of the Constitution and the Chairman has yet to make a nomination of a candidate for Treasurer.
- (c). The vacancy in the Office of Treasurer leaves the Tribe and its assets vulnerable and at risk.

Section 1.4 Selection of Treasurer

The Legislature hereby directs the Chairman to make an immediate nomination of a qualified candidate for Treasurer of the Tribe; provided, that if the Chairman makes no nomination of a candidate for Treasurer within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Act, then the Vice Chairman is hereby directed to nominate a qualified candidate for Treasurer, subject to confirmation by the Legislature.
