#### **KIOWA TRIBE RESOLUTION NO. KL-CY-2021-0004** ELIMINATION OF THE USE OF NATIVE IMAGERY AS MASCOTS IN THE STATE OF COLORADO

At a duly called Regular Session of the Legislature of the Kiowa Tribe held on this 8th day of May, 2021, the following Resolution was adopted.

The Legislature is vested with the authority to pass laws and resolutions WHEREAS;

pursuant to Article VI, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the Kiowa Tribe; and,

The Kiowa Tribe is vested with the sacred duty to protect the physical, WHEREAS;

psychological, emotional, and spiritual wellbeing of its most treasured gifts – its

children; and,

The continued use of Native imagery for race-based Indian logo, mascot, and WHEREAS:

> name symbolism has a profound negative impact on the psyche of American Indian children as proven by the research of Dr. Cornel Pewewardy, Dr.

Stephanie Fryberg and others; and,

The State of Colorado is considering legislation to ban use of Native imagery by WHEREAS;

> its public schools to prohibit continued use of stereotypes which detracts from the proud history, cultures, and traditions of Native peoples, and is harmful to

Native children; and,

WHEREAS: The Kiowa Legislature supports the efforts of their fellow Legislators in the State

of Colorado to eliminate continued use of race-based Native logos, mascots, and

names from its public schools; and,

NOW THEREFORE IT BE IT RESOLVED; that the Kiowa Legislature hereby calls for the elimination of race-based Native logos, mascots, and names from public schools in the State of Colorado.

The foregoing resolution was duly voted upon by the Legislature on May 8th, 2021, at a meeting with a vote of (5) in favor and (2) opposed, (0) absent, and (0) abstaining pursuant to the authority vested in the Legislature by the Constitution of the Kiowa Tribe.

The Kiowa Legislature held Regular Session XLIX on May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021 as specified in the Constitution of the Kiowa Tribe. The Legislature approved Resolution/Bill KL-CY-2021-0004, please see attachment for the Chairman's approval or veto.

 Resolution KL-CY-2021-0004; Elimination of the Use of Native Imagery as Mascots in the State of Colorado

The Kiowa Tribe Legislature is required to request and received back the resolution/laws within ten (10) days of presentment in accordance with the Constitution of the Kiowa Tribe, ARTICLE VII – EXECUTIVE BRANCH: (f) The Chairman shall have the power to sign any enactment passed by the Legislature into law or to veto with written explanations any enactment passed by the Legislature within ten days of passage and presentment of a certified enactment from the Legislature to the Chairman; provided, that if the Chairman takes no action within ten days, the enactment shall become law in accordance with this Constitution.
