KIOWA TRIBE RESOLUTION NO. KL-CY-2021-005

AUTHORIZATION TO CONDUCT BUSINESS WITH THE OFFICE OF SPECIAL TRUSTEE FOR AMERICAN INDIANS

At a duly called Session of the Legislature of the Kiowa Tribe held this 8th day of May 2021, the following Resolution and Law were adopted.

WHEREAS; the Kiowa Tribe is a sovereign nation since time immemorial and is federally recognized as a Tribal Government by the United States; and,

WHEREAS; the Legislature is vested with the authority to pass laws and resolutions pursuant to Article VI, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the Kiowa Tribe, and to pass Legislative Orders pursuant to Article VI, Section 6(c); and,

WHEREAS; the following individuals are recognized by Resolution to conduct the legislative and executive business of the Tribe:

WHEREAS; the Kiowa Tribe Elected Officials listed above have been duly elected to engage in and conduct legislative and executive business with the Office of Special Trustee for American Indians, unless noted differently by tribal resolution; and,

WHEREAS; this authority includes but is not restricted to the following actions: request disbursements, request access to tribal records, request copies of tribal records and provide tribal investment objectives and case needs by law.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislature hereby authorizes and approves the Kiowa Tribe elected officials to conduct business with the Office of Special Trustee for American Indians.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislature hereby authorizes the Chairman and the Speaker of the Legislature to officially notify the Office of Special Trustee for American Indians of any changes in the names of the elected officials of the Tribe as listed above, and such authorization shall expire on August 31, 2022.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Legislature hereby enacted the attached law entitled, "AUTHORIZATION TO CONDUCT BUSINESS WITH THE OFFICE OF SPECIAL TRUSTEE FOR AMERICAN INDIANS".

Section 1.1 Short Title

This enactment shall be known as the, "AUTHORIZATION TO CONDUCT BUSINESS WITH THE OFFICE OF SPECIAL TRUSTEE FOR AMERICAN INDIANS.

Section 1.2 Findings.

- (a) The Kiowa Tribe is a sovereign nation since time immemorial and is federally recognized as a Tribal Government by the United States;
- (b) The Legislature is vested with the authority to pass laws and resolutions pursuant to Article VI, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the Kiowa Tribe, and to pass Legislative Orders pursuant to Article VI, Section 6(c);
- (c) The following individuals are recognized by Resolution to conduct the legislative and executive business of the Tribe:

- (d) The Kiowa Tribe Officials listed above have been duly elected to engage in and conduct legislative and executive business with the Office of Special Trustee for American Indians, unless noted differently by a Kiowa Tribe Legislature resolution;
- (e) This authority includes but is not restricted to the following actions: request disbursements, request access to tribal records, request copies of tribal records and provide tribal investment objectives and case needs by law.

Section 1.3 Purpose.

The purpose of this law is to authorize the Chairman and Legislature to conduct the legislative and executive business of the Tribe with the Office of Special Trustee for American Indians including but not limited to requests for disbursements, access and copies of records, and providing the Tribe's investment objectives and case needs by law.

Section 1.4 Authorization to Conduct Business with the Office of Special Trustee.

- (a) The Legislature hereby authorizes and approves the Kiowa Tribe elected officials to conduct business with the Office of Special Trustee for American Indians.
- (b) The Legislature hereby authorizes the Chairman and the Speaker of the Legislature to officially notify the Office of Special Trustee for American Indians of any changes in the names of the elected officials of the Tribe as listed above, and such authorization shall expire on August 31, 2022.

 Resolution KL-CY-2021-0005; Authorization to Conduct Business with the Office of Special Trustee for American Indians

The Kiowa Tribe Legislature is required to request and received back the resolution/laws within ten (10) days of presentment in accordance with the Constitution of the Kiowa Tribe, ARTICLE VII – EXECUTIVE BRANCH: (f) The Chairman shall have the power to sign any enactment passed by the Legislature into law or to veto with written explanations any enactment passed by the Legislature within ten days of passage and presentment of a certified enactment from the Legislature to the Chairman; provided, that if the Chairman takes no action within ten days, the enactment shall become law in accordance with this Constitution.
