KIOWA TRIBE FIRST BUDGET MODIFICATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024

At a duly called session of the Legislature of the Kiowa Tribe held this 01, day of March, 2024, the following resolution and law were adopted:

WHEREAS, The Legislature is vested with the authority to pass an annual budget and budget modification for the Tribe pursuant to the Legislative process, and subject to approval by the voters, and

WHEREAS, The Legislature shall have the power to consider any budget proposals presented to the Legislature by the Chairman. The Legislature shall have the power to accept the budget proposal presented by the Chairman or develop its own budget proposals, and

WHEREAS, The Legislature shall have the power to pass an annual budget and budget modifications pursuant to the Legislative process.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Legislature hereby enacts the attached "Kiowa Tribe First Budget Modification for Fiscal Year 2023-2024", subject to final approval by the voters.

CERTIFICATION

The foregoing resolution KL-CY-2024-004 was duly voted upon by the Legislature on March 01, 2024, at a Legislative Special Session I-(1) with a vote of (6) in favor and (0) opposed, (0) abstain, and (1) absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Legislature by the Constitution of the Kiowa Tribe.

Section 1.1 Short Title

This enactment shall be known as the "Kiowa Tribe First Budget Modification for Fiscal Year 2023-2024".

Section 1.2 Purpose

The purpose of the Act is to approve a First Budget Modification for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 for the Tribe, subject to final approval by the voters.

Section 1.3 Findings

The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:

- (a) The Legislature is vested with the authority to pass an Annual Budget, and budget modifications, for the Tribe, subject to approval by the voters.
- (b) The Kiowa Constitution, which requires an annual budget and any budget modifications, to be approved by the Legislature and Chairman, with final approval by the voters.
- (c) The Legislature has identified the need to enact the "First Budget Modification for Fiscal Year 2023-2024" to include unidentified revenue and expenditures, including newly received funds and to address additional funding needs.
- (d) The Tribe shall operate on a fiscal year beginning July 1st and ending June 30th, Article 6, Section 6 (v) The Legislature shall have the power to raise revenue and appropriate funds for expenditure. Every funding item in an annual budget must have been previously authorized by law. No monies shall be drawn from the Treasury except by signature of the Chairman and except upon authorization and appropriation by law.

Section 1.4 Approval of the Kiowa Tribe First Budget Modification for Fiscal Year 2024

The Legislature hereby approves the "Kiowa Tribe First Budget Modification for Fiscal Year 2023-2024", subject to final approval by the voters as listed below.
