RESOLUTION OF THE KIOWA TRIBE LEGISLATURE AUTHORIZING SOVEREIGN BANK ACCOUNTS, SIGNERS, POWERS GRANTED AND LIMITATIONS.

At a duly called Session of the Legislature of the Kiowa Tribe held this 21st day of June 2024, the following Resolution was adopted directing Kiowa Tribe Elected Officials, Lawrence SpottedBird, Chairman, and Jacob Tsotigh, Vice-Chairman, establish bank accounts for the Kiowa Tribe at Sovereign Bank, a bank owned by the Citizen Potawatomi Nation, with branches in Lawton, Oklahoma. The opening of new accounts will require two (2) signature authorizations from both Lawrence SpottedBird, Chairman and Jacob Tsotigh, Vice-Chairman.

WHEREAS, the Kiowa Tribe (the “Tribe”) is organized under a constitution, duly adopted and approved by the voters of the Tribe on April 17, 2017 and approved by the U.S. Secretary of the Interior (“Secretary”)(the “Constitution”); and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VI, Section 6(a) of the Constitution, the Legislature is vested with the authority to pass laws and resolutions, including the power to authorize the Chairman to enter into contracts for financial and banking services; and,

WHEREAS, the Tribe has a need to invest and secure its financial resources; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has determined that entering into a contract with Sovereign Bank and establishing a banking relationship with Sovereign Bank is in the Kiowa Tribe’s best financial interest; and

WHEREAS, the Sovereign Bank has requested the Tribe to determine who is officially authorized to act as Agents for the Tribe and to exercise certain powers as indicated below;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislature hereby authorizes the following persons and positions to be designated agents of the Tribe in all transactions with Sovereign Bank:



NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the following powers are granted to the persons named above by listing the letter corresponding to their name above before each power. Following each power, it is indicated the number of Agent signatures required to exercise the power:

presentment, protest, notice of protest and notice of non-

maintaining, accessing and terminating a Safe Deposit

and powers, including Inquiry Only Authorization.”
(If D exercises this power in the absence of C, either A or B

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED, the Legislature declares:

- 7) Sovereign Bank is designated as a depository for the funds of the Kiowa Tribe and is to provide other financial accommodations as indicated by this Resolution;
- 8) This Resolution shall continue to be in full force and effect until express written notice of its rescission or modification has been received and recorded by Sovereign Bank. Any revocation, modification or replacement of this resolution received by Sovereign Bank must be accompanied by a Legislature Resolution;
- 9) The signature of an Agent on this resolution is conclusive evidence of their authority to act on behalf of the Kiowa Tribe. Any Agent, so long as they act in a representative capacity as an Agent of the Tribe, is authorized to make any and all other contracts, agreements, stipulations and orders which they may deem advisable for the effective exercise of powers as indicated on Page 2, from time to time with the Sovereign Bank, subject to any restrictions of this resolution or otherwise agree to in writing;
- 10) All transactions, if any, with respect to any deposits, withdrawals, rediscounts, and borrowings by or on behalf of the Tribe with the Sovereign Bank prior to the adoption of this resolution are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.
- 11) The Tribe agrees to the terms and conditions of any account agreement, properly opened by any Agent of the Tribe. The Tribe authorizes Sovereign Bank, at any time, to charge the Tribe for all checks, drafts, or other orders, for the payment of money, that are drawn on Sovereign Bank, so long as they contain the required number of signatures for this purpose.
- 12) The Tribe acknowledges and agrees that Sovereign Bank may furnish at its discretion automated access devices to Agents of the Tribe to facilitate those powers authorized by this resolution or other resolutions in effect at the time of issuance. The term "automated access device" includes, but is not limited to, purchase cards (aka "P-cards"), credit cards, automated teller machines (ATM), and debit cards.

CERTIFICATION

The foregoing Resolution KL-CY-2024-011 was duly voted upon by the Legislature on June 21, 2024, at a Legislative Special Session III-(3), with a vote of (5) in favor and (0) opposed, (0) abstaining, and (2) absent, according to the authority vested in the Legislature by the Constitution of the Kiowa Tribe.
